

# Two Travelaholics' Coachella Camping Checklist

Pack for 100-degree heat during the day and 50-degree cold at night

## Footwear

- Sandals/flip-flops/thongs/jandals
- Closed-toed shoes and socks
- Shower shoes

## Sleeping

- Foam tiles/camping mat/inflatable mattress
- Sheets/blanket/sleeping bag
- Tent/cabana/pop-up
- Tarp/canopy
- Plastic or rubber mallet (for pounding tent stakes into the ground)

## Drinking and Eating

- Cooler(s)
- Ice or dry ice
- Camping Grill/propane tanks
- Plastic utensils/cups/plates/bowls
- Beer (1-case per person allowed)
- Wine (boxes allowed, no glass)
- Water (better to bring too much than not enough)
- Instant coffee packets or energy drinks
- Nalgene/camelback/reusable bottle
- Pedialyte or EmergenC powder
- Dry, non-perishable goods (trail mix, nuts, etc.)
- Can opener
- Paper towels or napkins

## Hanging out

- Car identifier (a flag, balloons or something else to post at your spot so you can remember where you parked)
- Flashlight or head torch
- Folding chairs/self-standing hammock/beanbag chairs
- Folding table
- Battery-powered or hand fan

## Personal care and hygiene

- Sunblock
- Sunglasses
- Bandana (good for dunking in water to keep you cool)
- First aid kit (bandages, Neosporin, a topical cream for allergic reactions, Benadryl, and Advil or Excedrin)
- Medication (Make sure that if you bring prescription medication you have it in the original container with your name. Security may check the label against your ID.)
- Toiletry bag (with all the necessities: soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, etc.)
- Quick-dry towel
- Hand towel
- Baby wipes
- Baby powder
- Vaseline
- Hand sanitizer
- Face wipes

## Safeguarding your stuff

- Travel neck pouch/fanny pack
- Small- or medium-sized backpack (also allowed in the venue)
